Summary

The aim of the project is to contribute to solving the global problem by creative upcycling of generated textile waste. HACHAI is a new type of seat bag that absorbs about 10 times more textile waste for its production than other similar products. It recycles used material from the automotive and furniture industries. HACHAI could be also easily recycled for further production of a new seat bag, or textile boards used in construction and transportation.
